# Contact and Airborne Precautions

**CONTACT PRECAUTIONS**  
**EVERYONE MUST:**



Clean their hands, including before entering and when leaving the room.

**PROVIDERS AND STAFF MUST ALSO:**



Put on gloves before room entry.  
Discard gloves before room exit.



Put on gown before room entry.  
Discard gown before room exit.

Do not wear the same gown and gloves for the care of more than one person.



Use dedicated or disposable equipment.  
Clean and disinfect reusable equipment before use on another person.

**1** Perform hand hygiene

**2** Put on N95 or P2 mask

**On leaving room**

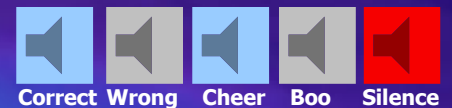
