


This disease was named after the Norwegian physician who in 1873 first identified the mycobacterium leprae as the causative agent.

Two French neurologists described this progressive paralytic condition in 1916. Rarely, vaccines such as influenza can cause this autoimmune disorder.










#### **Chagas Disease AKA American Tripanosomiasis**

#### Smallpox










One in three people will experience this disease during their lifetime. A complication in 10-18% of cases is severe nerve pain in the affected region that can last for years.

This type of tourism surged after the COVID19 pandemic as people's desire to travel overcame their concerns about the disease. It is a way of making up for lost experiences.


